



Billing

If you are a customer who receives service from Marin Clean Energy (MCE), your billing will still be managed by Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E). PG&E will send you your bill and you will remit your payment to PG&E.

There will be a generation charge on your PG&E bill that will be remitted to MEA.
